INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR THE HAMBRICK FOUNDATION ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. In order to be considered for this scholarship, a complete TYPED application packet MUST be returned by DECEMBER 15, 2023.
- 2. Omission of any part of the application will eliminate the application from consideration.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. Scholarship Amount: 1st Place \$2,500; 2nd Place \$1,500; 3rd Place \$1,000.
- 5. Scholarship recipients are asked to attend an award presentation ceremony hosted by The Hambrick Foundation. Award recipients will be notified of the time and location of the award ceremony after judging is complete.
- Please return completed application packet to your guidance counselor or directly to the scholarship committee via email or regular mail by the deadline. If using regular mail, application must be postmarked by the deadline of December 15th.
- 7. Please submit a recommendation letter from EACH of the following:
 - **ACADEMIC RECOMMENDATION** letter from a Core Academic Teacher (Math, Science, Language Arts/English, Social Studies/History).
 - **CHARACTER RECOMMENDATION** letter from a Minister, Civic Leader, or Professional Person; not a parent or family member.
- 8. Please have your references submit a typed letter of recommendation for you. The letters should be addressed to The Hambrick Foundation Scholarship Committee and include:

Name and occupation of reference
The name of the applicant and relationship
How long the reference has known the applicant
Information regarding how the applicant have impacted their community
